

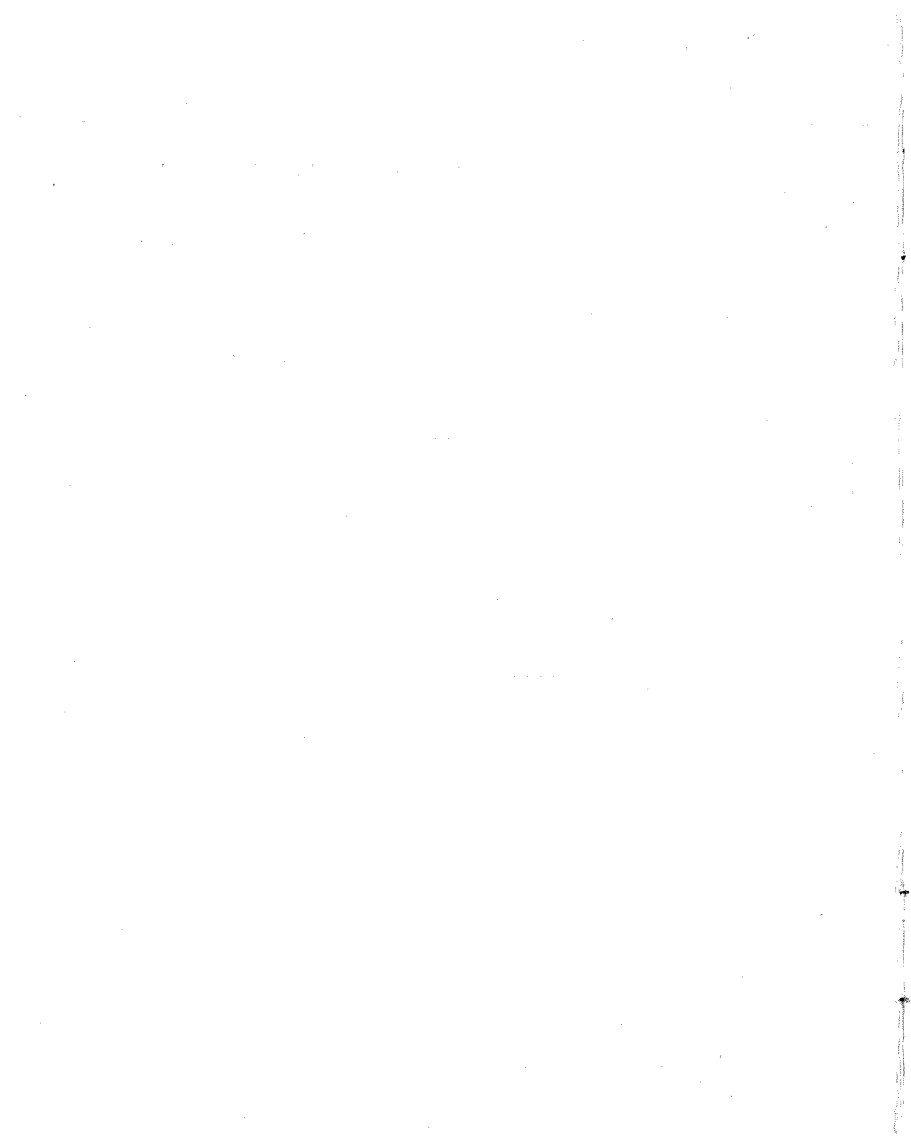

TELEGRAPH CODE.

DESPATCH IS A BASIC PRINCIPLE OF THE TELEGRAPH SYSTEM.

In order that the Morse Instruments may be utilised to the best advantage, Senders should make full use of the Authorised Code terms and Code Addresses, and avoid using superfluous words.

The Uniform Telegraph Code, which is printed in heavy **black type**, applies throughout the Government Railway Systems of the Commonwealth.

The Code words and Phrases printed in ordinary capitals, and small type respectively and the Code Addresses shown on pages 17-20 are for use in Victoria only.

INSTRUCTIONS.

The Telegraph is only for messages which will not permit of the delay involved in transmission by train.

All concerned must become conversant with the code, and use it as fully as possible. Code words are not to be used in paid telegrams.

Operators must transmit messages exactly as they are coded and handed to them.

Signal "D.G." will take precedence over all other business. Upon its receipt the transmission of all messages on the line must **instantly cease**; this call must only be used in cases of **utmost urgency or accidents**.

Signal "L.C." is to be used for "Line Clear" messages, and is to be superseded by the "D.G." signal only.

Signal "G.M." is for matters of urgency, and will take precedence over all ordinary business. "G.M." is next in importance to "L.C."

Signal "T.A." takes precedence over ordinary business, and may be used when necessary for obtaining circuit to report trains in and out, or in connection with Special train advices, etc.
