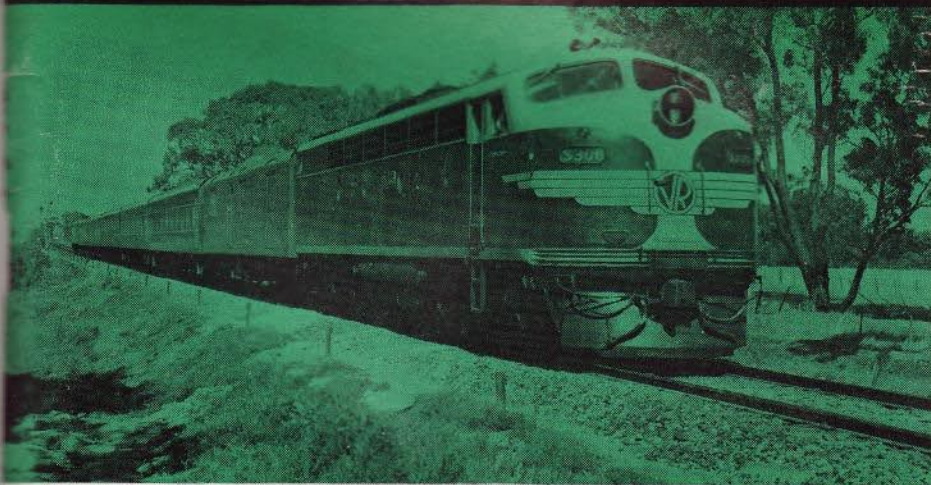

PRAMS AND PUSHERS

Prams can be taken inside compartments of metropolitan trains timed to reach Melbourne after 9.30 a.m. and before 4 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays and again after 6 p.m. Return anytime except between 4 p.m. and 6 p.m. There is no time restriction on Saturdays, Sundays, and public holidays.

Maximum width of pram:

- 1170 mm in silver trains
- 660 mm in blue trains
- 560 mm in red trains

Rates for the carriage of prams in metropolitan trains are:

- Single journey 12 cents
- Return journey 24 cents

Prams and pushers are carried free on country trains, if they are under 15 kg., if above they are charged at the appropriate rates.



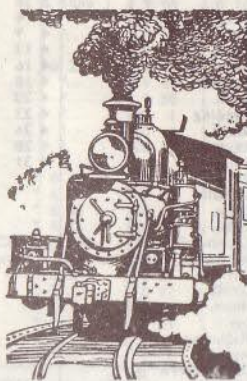

STAMPS FOR PARCELS

Denominations of stamps for pre-paid parcels have been selected so that generally no more than two are required.

Stamps must be put on parcels by the sender and must not overlap.

Whenever practicable they should go in the right hand top corner above and near the address, or when the nature of the package does not permit this, on the back of an address label.

CALCULATING DISTANCES

Parcel rates are computed on the distance by the shortest route from one station to another. Station staff will be happy to help with any calculations. Distances of railway stations from Melbourne are given on pages 4-15. Interstate parcel rates are available from local station staff.
